Meeting Minutes

Old Business:

Coin Show Director, Ken D., announced that the FRCC Spring Coin Show setup would be held in the morning on March 10th as a reminder to the volunteers who offered to help with setup. The show is sold out, and the weather should be great, so he is looking forward to a great show!

New Business:

Member David F. reported on his experience at the National Money Show in Phoenix in early March. It was surprisingly cold and rainy, with snow on the mountains. There was a lot of dealer to dealer selling and trading, and despite the weather, it was quite well attended by the public.

There was a dealer with a solid block of large head \$10 banknotes from all districts, with all serial numbers being complete 9s. The set was going to auction starting at \$150,000, with an expected sale price of around \$250,000!

Member Bob C. reported that Tebo Coin in Boulder recently acquired a rare set of ten consecutive 2003 two dollar bills. The first and the last notes were normal, but the eight in between had inverted overprinting. All were sent as a set to PMG for grading and are expected to receive Mint State grades. Presentation(s)

There was no formal presentation at this meeting. President Dave J. led a brief discussion regarding the high demand and value of some national banknotes due to their rarity caused by low print quantities and the general lack of survivability of paper banknotes. National banknotes were produced by the Federal Reserve for local banks. Banks used to register with the Fed, and the Bureau of Printing and Engraving would print the cash for the bank. National Bank Notes: A Guide with Prices by Don C. Kelly was recommended as a resource for members interested in learning more about these historic collectible notes. New copies are fairly expensive, but used copies can be found around the internet at a discount.


