This nuanced grading concept is critical when selecting coins with greater detail and has an impact on the overall grade that can cause significant value fluctuations. A

weakly struck coin may not have the eye appeal of a well struck coin with light wear, but it may carry a higher price tag as it will likely grade higher than the coin with wear.


