Meeting Minutes

New Business:

This Friday, December 13th will be the club's 2024 Holiday Party. Doors open at 6 PM, and food will be served at 7 PM. The club will be purchasing entrées and sides from Burgers' Smokehouse. Members are invited to bring side dishes and desserts as well, though not obligatory.

Presentation(s)

There was not a formal presentation at this meeting.

Vice President Joe G. asked Dan C. to speak on the upcoming club medal production. Dan may bring sculpts to show at the next meeting. He has the idea for the theme to use a design stylized after a stock certificate vignette from the Colorado Midland Railway. He is going to replicate parts of the design to engrave the image into the die, which will then be stamped into the metal. He then wants to patina and burnish the

medal so the grooves show up darkened against the satin fields. The medal will be 50 mm, two ounces of silver, so there will be more room for the design to show.

Dan also described his process for preparing planchets from scratch, including rolling ingots, punching the planchets, and finishing the surfaces via a variety of methods to prepare them to be struck and finished with their intended design.

Each club member will receive a copper medal, and silver medals will be sold at a future date. We will announce the price and sale date in the future.

The club is very excited about the medal and is looking forward to its release in 2025.


