## Meeting Minutes

### **Old Business:**

### **New Business:**

Ken provided a show report for the upcoming Sept 20-21 FRCC Coin Show. This will be the biggest show ever based on the increase from 66 to 72 tables. All tables are sold with zero wait listed. Food and security are arranged. Ken asked for volunteers to help with the show.

Dan C. sold his 1921 bronze Peace dollar galvano at the Heritage auction as part of the ANA show in Oklahoma City in August for \$132,000. Daniel brought this "Broken Sword" uniface galvano to show to club members about a year ago in August 2024.

## Presentation(s)

Vice President Joe G. brought his recently acquired US Palladium bullion coin and shared some interesting info on Palladium (Pd) and Palladium coinage. Palladium was discovered in 1803 and is 30 times rarer than gold but 1/3 the price of gold.


The United States began producing \$25 Pd bullion coins in 2017 in various finishes (Unc, Proof, and Reverse Proof). Mintages of these coins are all below 20,000 so they are modern day rarities.

The obverse features a high relief version of Adolph Weinman's winged liberty design more commonly referred to as the "Mercury" dime. The reverse is based on Weinman's eagle design from his 1907 American Institute of Architects gold medal.




Other countries (Canada, Australia, etc) have produced palladium bullion coins, which are a somewhat cheaper investment alternative to gold as gold is setting record high prices weekly.

John F. gave a presentation on "Collecting Jefferson Nickels". John shared his collecting journey from filling Whitman folders as a kid to competitive registry sets as an adult to becoming a coin dealer in 2024. All throughout these ~50 years of collecting was a passion for Jefferson nickels.



John discussed mintages and varieties from the first year of 1938 up to the mid-1970s. He plans to present a follow up program covering modern Jefferson nickels in a future presentation.



After the presentation, John raffled off an uncirculated 1959 "Black Beauty" nickel made from improperly annealed planchets. Joe G. won the raffle.
